

Dear voice actor,

Thank you for agreeing to lend your voice to Battle of Bodenplatte. Please use Audacity to record your voice tracks. It's very easy to use. You can download it from this link. Install takes just a few seconds. You just need a decent microphone (like a gaming headset) set to a reasonable volume.

Instructions:

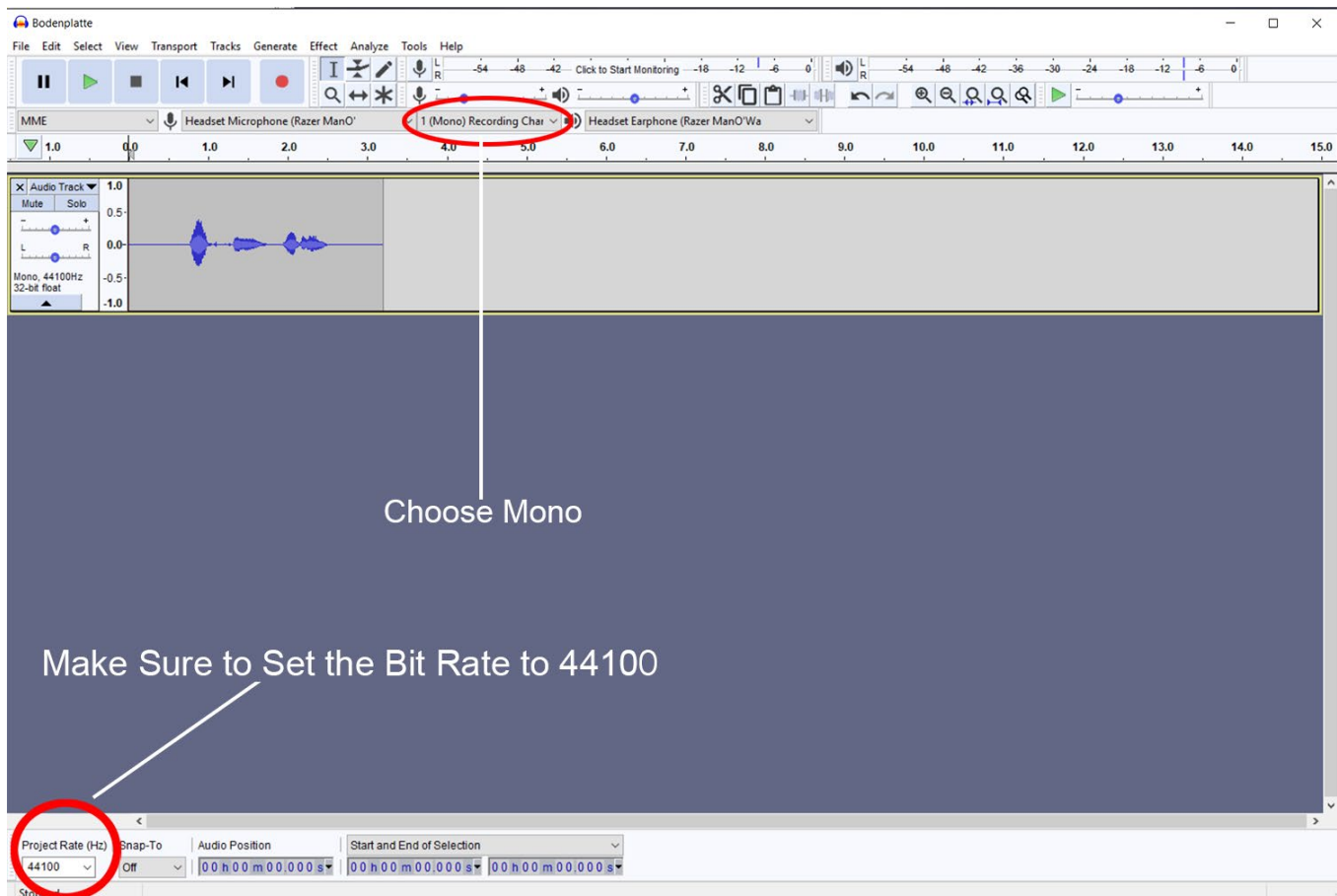
1. Create four folders - Pilot, Airfield, Spotter and Gunner
2. As you record, name each file according to the spreadsheet i.e. Pilot_35, Airfield_2, Spotter_9, Gunner_5 etc.
3. Just follow the script and voice each line as indicated – Neutral, Tense or Excited. Record all lines for all types.
4. Choose the correct script for your nationality as they differ a bit (American or British).
5. Be mindful of small breaks in your speaking indicated by a comma or dash. These small, but natural breaks leave a tiny bit of room to clip each bit so we can rearrange and combine with other bits when necessary.
6. Save each recording into the proper folder.
7. Simply zip up all the folders and send to Jason. The deadline is January 31st, 2019. We are behind schedule so time is short.

Our sound engineer will cut up your work as necessary to create all radio transmissions etc. The scripts are designed to create a natural sounding cadence even when chopped up so try to be consistent in how your unique voice sounds throughout. Please don't worry about repeating certain words several times. The script you see here is part of a larger system that is more complex than appears at first glance.

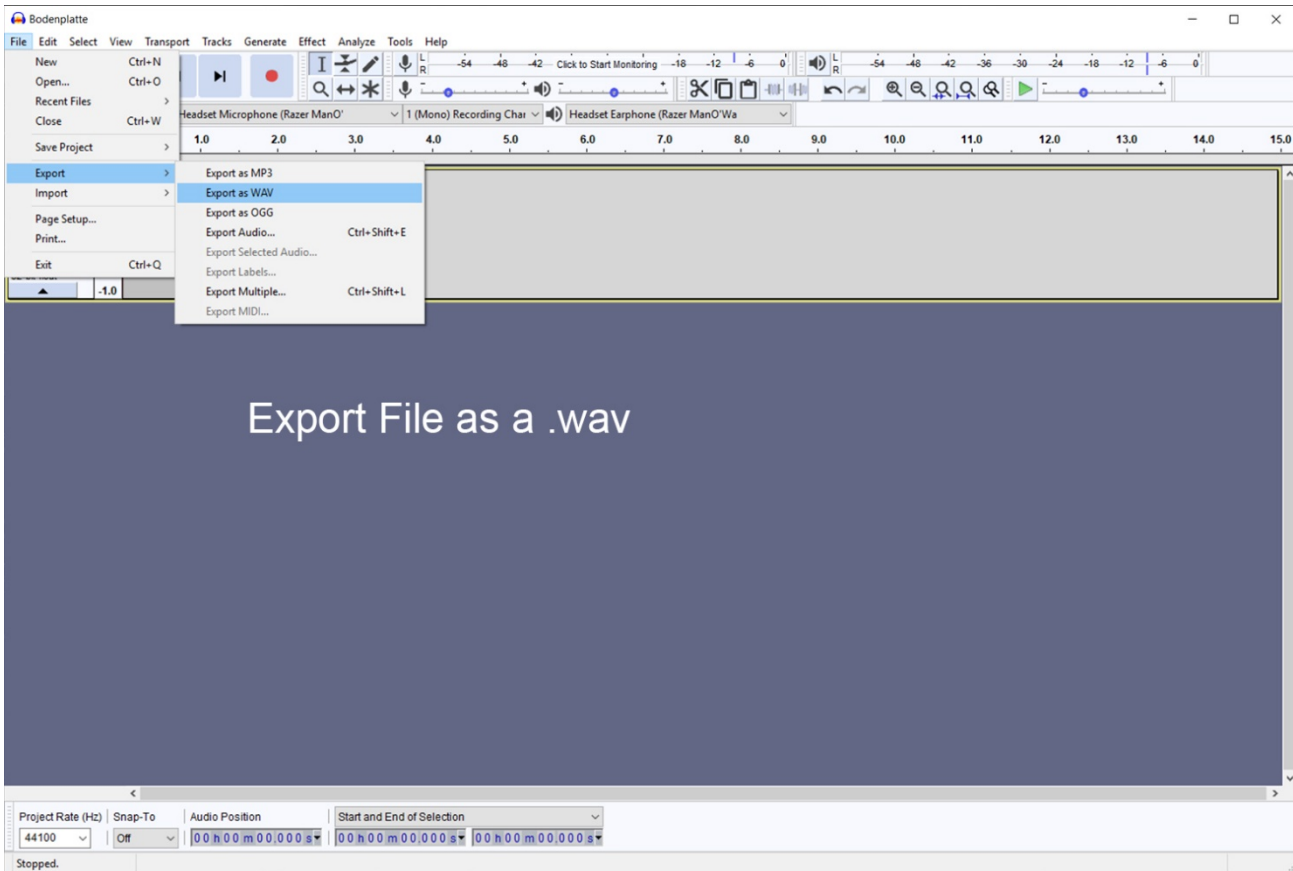
Please do not "over act" or put on a fake accent. Just be yourself. Please listen to the included samples provided by Jason.

How to use Audacity app.

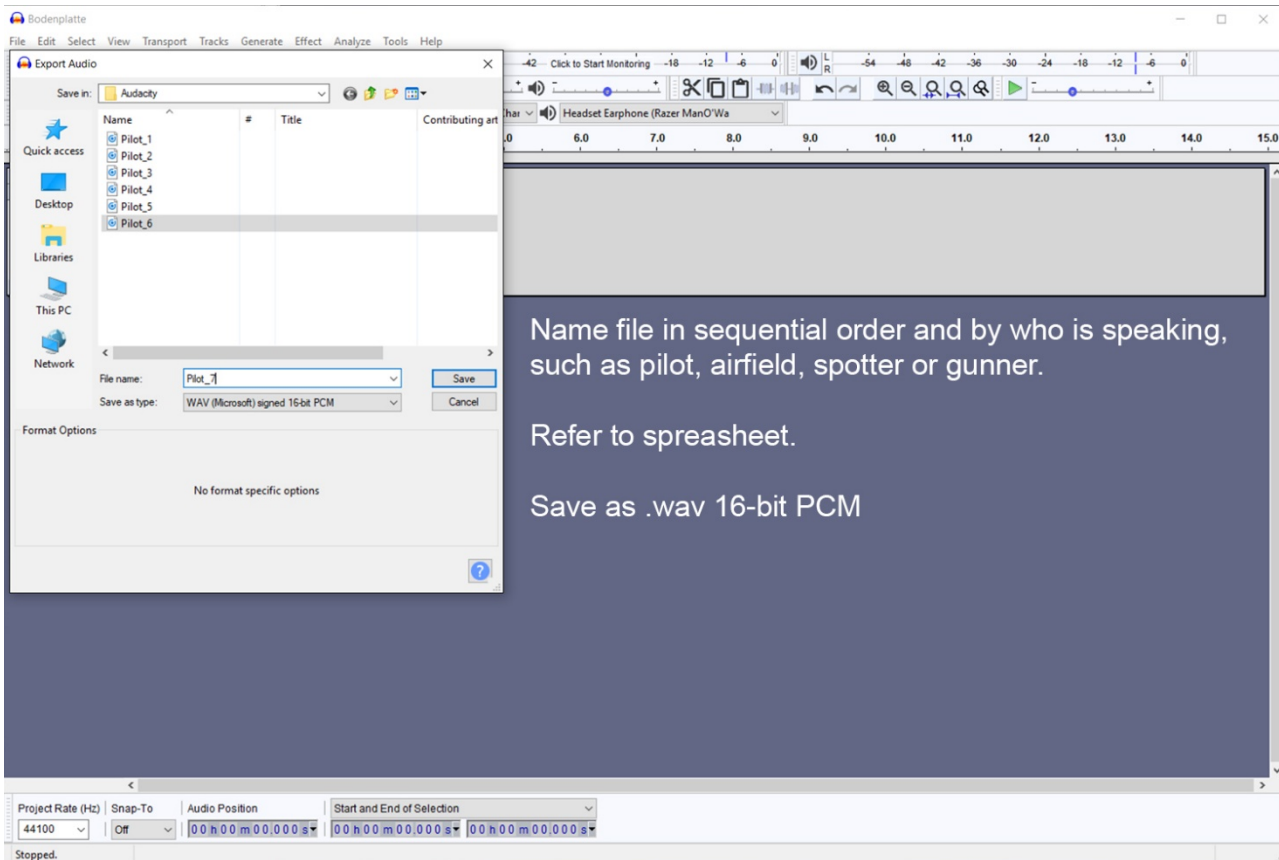
Step 1. Install and Record Settings
